



Dear Parents/Guardians,

We are writing with information on how to access remote learning, should your child be required to isolate due to Covid-19. There are a small number of reasons your child may need to self-isolate. These are outlined below.

- Your child has tested positive for Covid-19 and is isolating for 10 days.
- Your child is in isolation due to close contact with a peer or a member of the household testing positive and is isolating for 14 days.
- Your child is displaying symptoms of Covid-19, has taken a test and is awaiting results
- Your child is in isolation due to a member of the household displaying symptoms and is awaiting test results.

If your child needs to self-isolate, we have been working on a bank of remote learning resources. These can be found on the 'Remote Learning' section of the website. You can find this by following this link; <https://www.kingshurst.tgacademy.org.uk/remote-learning/> - or by going to the top menu bar of the website. Here, you will find the following information: updated links to staff contacts; guidance on how to access BromCom and Teams; wellbeing activities; links to government guidance and a link to BromCom where you will find subject learning grids. Students should begin every day with 20-minutes silent reading (or reading with an adult at home) and should follow the lessons on their in-school timetable for the rest of their day. They should use the task grids to signpost where to find each lesson resource. Essentially a student should follow the structure of the day below and this will ensure that they are keeping on-track with their peers in school.
