



Dear Parents/Guardians,

We are writing with information on how to access remote learning, during the current National Lockdown that we are expecting to last until February Half-Term.

We have been also been working on a bank of remote learning resources. These can be found on the 'Remote Learning' section of the website. Here, you will find the following information: updated links to staff contacts; guidance on how to access Teams and BromCom; wellbeing activities; links to government guidance and supplementary resources.

Students should begin every day Monday to Thursday with 20-minutes silent reading (or reading with an adult at home) and on a Friday attend their live online TEAMS tutor session. All students should then follow the lessons on their in-school timetable for the rest of their day. An outline of this for each year group is below:

We have the following expectations for all our remote learning lessons:

- All lessons will have a calendar invite so that students are aware of the timetabled lesson.
- Remote learning lessons will have a 20-minute live-input. This might also link to pre-recorded lessons.
- Teachers will be available online, to support, help and guide students for the duration of the lesson.
- Registers will be taken within the first 10 minutes of the lesson and absences will be followed up.
- Assessment of learning is required, with a longer assessment piece being carried out every two weeks.
- Rewards and sanctions will still be logged by staff and followed up as required.
- Teachers who are absent from school will be covered so lessons will go ahead.
- All lessons will be delivered remotely and work will be on TEAMS, work packs will not be sent out.
