

FIRE INSTRUCTIONS

- 1. If you discover a fire, immediately raise the alarm.
 - There is an alarm call point in every corridor.
- 2. On hearing the fire alarm, leave the building by the nearest available escape route (follow the green signs) and make your way to your assembly point:
 - D Block 3G pitch
 - A Block Tennis courts
 - Staff, visitors & contractors Tennis courts
- 3. Do not take any coats or bags with you
- 4. Turn off room lights & equipment
- 5. Close room doors
- 6. Walk quickly but **DO NOT RUN**
- 7. Follow the green 'running man' signs to the nearest exit



- 8. **Do not** use lifts: if you cannot use the stairs, wait for assistance at the refuge point on the stairs
- 9. Keep in single file and maintain social distancing if possible
- 10.Keep silent and listen carefully for instructions
- 11.Once you have left your room or building, do not return
- 12.Line up with your group in alphabetical order
- 13.In the event of a fire on or close to the 3G or tennis courts themselves, you will be redirected to another location
- 14. Listen carefully for any further instructions and eventual dismissal

The fire alarm is a continuous siren

In the event of a malfunction with the alarm system, verbal evacuation instructions will be given
