Trip Details:

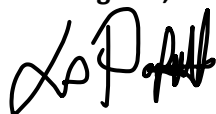
- **Date:** Wednesday 21st October 2026
- **Arrival time:** Students should aim to arrive at the academy by **8:15am** and report directly to the main hall
- **Departure time:** 8:40am from the academy
- **Return time:** Approximately **6:00pm** to the academy
- **Travel:** By coach
- **Cost:** Free of charge: subsidised by the academy as part of our effort to increase opportunities and personal development.
- **Lunch:** Students should bring a packed lunch and a drink. There will also be opportunities to buy snacks at the museum also. Students who are in receipt of free school meals will be provided with a packed lunch, which must be collected from the dining hall on the morning of the trip before departure.
- **Dress code:** Full school uniform.
- **Spending Money** – There will be chance to visit the gift shop or purchase a snack from the canteen at the museum. A rough guide would be no more than £20.
