Re: Launch of 'The Right Way' System – High Expectations for All

Dear Parents and Carers,

At the CTC, we're continuously striving to set high expectations for all our students in relation to their conduct, attitudes and outcomes. As part of our continued effort to further raise standards for all, the academy has introduced **'The Right Way'**, a comprehensive and consistent approach to ensuring and encouraging positive attitudes from our students toward learning, both within and outside of the classroom.

'The Right Way' has been launched with all students and staff at the start of this half-term in order to share with students the very clear expectations the academy holds. Underpinning this approach are three core values: being *ready*, *respectful* and *responsible*. We have created various opportunities in form time, during assemblies and within lessons to communicate what is expected of students in line with **'The Right Way'** approach and, as always, appreciate your continued support as parents and carers in encouraging your child to meet these expectations.

To reward Key Stage 3 students for demonstrating that they embrace the values of being *ready*, *respectful* and *responsible*, the academy has launched **'The Right Way'** loyalty card, where students can collect up to six stamps outside of lessons and during break and lunch times in order to receive a privilege pass for queues in the canteen and a 'treat' item.



Students should keep this card in the back of their lanyard along with their ID card so that they are ready to receive the acknowledgment from members of staff for behaving positively and respectfully around the academy.

In order to provide a review of the expectations for students at the academy, please find enclosed for your reference a copy of **'The Right Way' – Expectations for Students and Guidance for Parents/Carers**, which brings together in one document many of the academy's long standing expectations. We hope that this outlines the requirements of students in terms of their appearance, conduct and use of facilities, and areas in which you can support us as parents and carers.
