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How can you use knowledge organisers at home to help us?

- **Retrieval Practice:** Read over a section of the knowledge organiser, cover it up and then write down everything you can remember. Repeat until you remember everything.
- **Flash Cards:** Using the Knowledge Organisers to help on one side of a piece of paper write a question, on the other side write an answer. Ask someone to test you by asking a question and seeing if you know the answer.
- **Mind Maps:** Turn the information from the knowledge organiser into a mind map. Then reread the mind map and on a piece of paper half the size try and recreate the key phrases of the mind map from memory.
- **Sketch it:** Draw an image to represent each fact; this can be done in isolation or as part of the mind map/flash card.
- **Teach it:** Teach someone the information on your knowledge organiser, let them ask you questions and see if you know the answers.

How will we use knowledge organisers in Spanish?

Vocabulary Learning Strategy 1: Look, say, cover, write, check

Use the five steps below to learn how to spell any word

LOOK

Look carefully at the word for at least 10 seconds

SAY

Say the word to yourself or out loud to practise pronunciation

COVER

Cover up the word when you feel you have learned it

WRITE

Write the word from memory

CHECK

Check your word against the original. Did you get it right?

If not, what did you get wrong?

Gramática

Hacer (to do) is an important irregular verb. The c changes to g in the 'I' form. Learn it by heart.

hago	I do
haces	you do
hace	he/she does
hacemos	we do
hacéis	you (plural) do
hacen	they do

Gramática

The verb ir (to go) is an important irregular verb.

ir	to go
voy	I go
vas	you go
va	he/she goes
vamos	we go
vais	you (plural) go
van	they go

Gramática

Jugar (to play) is a stem-changing verb. Some people call these 'boot' verbs.

juego	I play	jugamos	we play
juegas	you play	jugáis	you (plural) play
juega	he/she plays	juegan	they play
