Opportunity Knocks

Believe it or not, despite a national lockdown, there are still opportunities available to you all out there.

Whether you are looking for advice and guidance about next steps, or looking to expand your horizons as part of a super-curricula activity, there are opportunities that often make there way through to the Sixth Form Team. Here are some of the recent highlights for you to consider.

Top Opportunities

- 1. **The University of Birmingham's annual Masterclass Programme** is now taking bookings for January 2021. The hour-long sessions will be hosted by experts in their field at the University of Birmingham and will cover a wide range of subject areas (Medicine, English Literature, Dentistry, Academic Writing, Politics, Art History, Maths). All Masterclasses are delivered online and are designed to provide you with insights into what it's like to study at a selective university. If you are unable to attend the live session, your can request recordings of available masterclasses by completing an individual masterclass recording request form (https://app.geckoform.com/public/#/modern/FOEU0260LVfEych3). This form will give you the opportunity to opt in to further communications from the University to hear about the other upcoming opportunities.
- 2. West Midlands Police:
 - For Year 13: West Midlands Police Force Recruitment is now open https://jobs.west-midlands.police.uk/police-officer-recruitment/am-i-eligible/ (you need to be predicted at least 96 UCAS points (e.g. CCC or DD or MMM) to apply https://www.ucas.com/ucas/tariff-calculator (please note the Graduate Recruitment is currently suspended as it is very oversub-scribed so students considering Policing with a UCAS application pending should also really consider applying now direct to a Police Force and have their studies paid for.)
 - For Year 12: Staffordshire University have a Police Virtual Recruitment Event on 11th Feb at 4pm.
