


Staff Training Day

Key Information:

- All students planning on applying to university are required to register. It is absolutely free to register for UCAS. The system will save the progress of your application, so you can complete it bit by bit, over time.
- When registering, UCAS will eventually ask you if you have a 'buzzword'. At this point please enter the 2. TGAK2022 buzzword. This will do two things, firstly, it will link you directly with the Academy and secondly, it will allow Mrs Armitage to be able to see what stage of the application you are at in order to provide intervention and support.
- At the very end of the process of applying to university (the deadline would occur during Year 13), you 3. would be required to pay a fee of just over £20 to 'send' your application. This fee pays for the service that UCAS provides of sending your application to all of the universities that you have applied to in addition to communicating all of their replies to you. Were you to change your mind at any point, you would therefore, never have to pay anything. It is totally free to register and to complete 99% of the application form.
