Over the course of the last half term, further feedback has allowed us the opportunity to respond to your feedback in the following ways:

1. You said: There are not enough revision guides in the Common Room.

We did: A tally has been completed of all the text books. To date all of the BTEC qualifications are represented, as are some of the A Level subjects. Where previous exam board revision guides are owned, we have included these on the book shelves as many will feature common themes and topics, but will present these in a different way which could be valuable. An order has been placed for all of the remaining A Level subjects—this includes A Level Biology, Physics, Chemistry, Mathematics, Geography and Psychology.

2. You said: You would like to do a charity fund raising event before Christmas.

We did: This request was put to the Senior Leadership Team who have agreed for the final day of term (Thursday 16th December) to be a Christmas themed non-uniform day. All proceeds are planned to go towards the Make a Wish Foundation (subject to the student leadership approving this.

3. You said: You did not like the Common Room being closed during the previous week.

We did: There is a commitment to sanction those individuals who are improperly using or failing to respect this crucial resource, banning these individuals from accessing the room where required. Rotations from Sixth Form team members have also increased throughout the area and will be sustained moving forwards in order to regularly check on standards.
