Were you to be impacted by COVID...

There are arrangements in place to support you to work remotely whilst absent, if well enough to work during isolation. You will be aware that we no longer need to send bubbles of students home to isolate, but do need to adhere to Government policy for students who have tested positive for Covid to isolate.

Just to make you all aware, we are still required to mark your attendance based upon your involvement in the lesson and engagement with the work set. Your teacher will be made aware of your absence via a daily email sent to all staff.



The expectations for remote learning are as follows:

- Students self-isolating will follow their normal timetable.
- PowerPoint and resources will be put into your class' TEAMs folder if you are self isolating.
- Your teacher will make contact with you/be ready to accept you into the lesson via Teams in order to be able to mark the register accurately and check understanding of work.
- Based upon the context of the class remote live lesson teaching by your teacher is optional. If a live lesson is being
 conducted, the screen will be shared to show the lesson PowerPoint and resources. Cameras are to be turned off.

We hope that this won't apply to you, but want to provide reassurance that you will still be supported were you required to isolate.
