Common Wealth Games-Thursday 28th July 2002- Monday 8th August


The Commonwealth Games is often referred to as the Friendly Games. It is an international multi-sport event involving athletes from across the commonwealth.

The games has a rich history of inclusivity, with athletes who have a disability being full members of their international teams. The last Commonwealth Games in 2018 became the first global multi-sport event to feature an equal number of men's and women's medal events.

Although there are currently 54 members of the Commonwealth of Nations, 72 teams currently participate in the Commonwealth Games, as it is a feature of the Commonwealth Games that a number of dependent territories who do not complete separately at the Olympic Games, complete in the Commonwealth Games under their own flag.

We hope you have all taken the opportunity to either participate as a volunteer or have taken the opportunity to apply for tickets to watch a sporting event. If not it is not too late to do either. It will be a great occasion for the city to embrace and for you to be involved in way one or another so do not miss the opportunity.
