



We Did: Xmas Charity

A desire to work towards supporting a charity was shared and we whole-heartedly agree with this sentiment.

In response to this, the Sixth Form will be leading on the Foodbank collection that will be taking place over the course of the festive period that will support the Kingfisher Foodbank that is located in Smith's Wood and is the nearest one to the Academy.

Between 1 April 2022 and 30 September 2022, food banks distributed 1.3million emergency food parcels to people in crisis. This is a 52% increase in comparison to the same period in 2019—it is worth considering that half a million of these parcels were distributed to children.

The Common Room will therefore be turning into the 'hub' for collections for the whole Academy to receive what we hope will be a significant donation that will take our tally as an Academy to over a ton of food donated over the last three years.

We very much hope that you all will play your part in considering purchasing an additional food item to bring in and donate yourself to help with the effort. Whether a pack of super noodles or a tin of soup—EVERY donation will help!

I also hope some of you will be prepared to volunteer your time during registration to help collect these donations from students at the Common Room. Let me know if you are interested or speak to your Assistant College Leader.
