#### Re: 13 mock examinations second round

Dear Families,

Please see details regarding the mock exam window for Y13 students. Your child will be provided with a copy of the mock examination timetable which begins on **Monday 14**<sup>th</sup> **January 2022**. Students have also been provided with a *JCQ student guidance* and *Information for Students* sheet which summarises expectations and protocol required during these examinations. These documents are also available on the academy (<a href="https://www.kingshurst.tgacademy.org.uk/about/examination-information/">https://www.kingshurst.tgacademy.org.uk/about/examination-information/</a>) and JCQ websites and any malpractice will be subject to these regulations. Please ensure you and your child have read these thoroughly before the start of exams.

Even though these are mock exams, we expect students to be fully committed in ensuring they are giving 100% effort to secure the best grades they can. At the moment, the Department for Education (DfE) had indicated that examinations will go ahead. However, we could have a similar scenario to last year where students were provided with centre assessed grades, based on evidence such as internal mock exams. This highlights the importance of these examinations and a continued focus from all students.

Morning exams will begin at 0900 and afternoon exams will begin at 1300.

Period 6 sessions will continue to run as normal to ensure we can support students in preparation for these, and future exams.

### Access arrangement support:

Any student who has access arrangement support is expected to utilise this to maximise their grade potential. The school access arrangement team will be working with these students separately to ensure the right support is being offered.

I am sure you will agree on the importance of these exam so we ask if you could ensure your child arrives on time to the academy, does not miss any exams, is prepared for them with the right equipment; x2 black pens, x2 pencils, clear ruler, scientific calculator, highlighter, eraser, and sharpener.
