To our community,

Today marks the end of another academic year, and I must admit, this has been a challenging one for all members of our community, but most importantly, our young people. It seems an age since we sent update letters about Covid-19 but we must remember that although this was our first full academic year since 2018, we are still feeling the impact of this pandemic. It was only February 2022, when the academy suffered 29 staff off with the virus, only a short twenty school weeks ago and so this disruption must not be underestimated. The resilience displayed by our young people has been astounding and the encouragement provided by families has been gratefully received. For your support, we will be always grateful.

Despite all of the challenges of this year, we have worked really hard to bring this academy back to life. And this has been a success.
