



Dear Parents/Guardians,

You may be aware from media coverage that the National Education Union (NEU) have declared strike action, which will take place on 1st February 2023. The strike is happening because of a national dispute between the unions and the government over pay, and not because of any issues at our school.

I'm getting in touch to give you as much notice as possible that learning may be disrupted on these dates. We're considering several options, including moving some lessons online and closing the school, for some students.

I'm sorry about the potential disruption to you and to your child's education. I understand that this situation may be frustrating and ask that all members of our school community continue to treat each other with respect. Tudor Grange Academy Kingshurst, remains committed to providing a safe and secure environment for our pupils and delivering high-quality teaching.

We are working closely with our staff union representatives to keep up to date with the situation, and I will inform you of the final arrangements as soon as possible.
