Re: Year 12 and Year 13 Plan for Industrial Action Day

You may be aware from media coverage that National Education Union (NEU) have declared industrial action, that will take place on **Wednesday 1st February 2023**.

I am writing to give you as much notice as possible about our arrangements for **Wednesday 1st February**. The plan for all Year 12 and Year 13 students is for them to follow their normal timetabled day in the same rooms as it would normally occur also.

In the event of any teacher being absent due to industrial action, a dedicated independent study room (D110) will be in place, monitored by either the Director of Sixth Form or Assistant College Leader for Sixth Form where students will be able to register and work effectively.

Form and reading	Registration in the Sixth Form Common Room.
Periods 1-5	Students to follow normal timetabled lessons. Where teacher is absent due to industrial action, students are required to attend D110 where they will be registered and able to work independently within this area. <i>Lunchtime also remains the same:</i> <i>Year 12: 12.30-1pm</i> <i>Year 13: 1.30-2pm</i>

We would expect all students to attend as normal to ensure they do not miss vital learning time and are required to follow our normal uniform, expectations, and standards, as would be the case in any other day within the Academy.
