Course options: What's the difference?

A Levels BTECs T-Levels

BTEC qualifications and T-Levels start to prepare you for **one subject** or vocational area, whereas A levels aim to give you a specific academic grounding in **several subjects** (usually 3, sometimes 4).

BTECs centre around coursework and a mixture of internal and external assessments and, often work placements, whereas A levels are much more classroom-based and tend to be assessed largely via final exams (depending on the subject - **check the % exam and course work for each A Level, T-Level and BTEC of interest to support your research**.

- A BTEC Extended Diploma is equivalent to 3 A Levels.
- A BTEC Diploma is equivalent to 2 A Levels so some colleges offer the option of a Diploma plus 1 A Level.

T- Levels will generally offer 20% Work Placement -based learning with the other 80% of your time learning in College. They are equivalent to 3 A Levels.
